Cardiac Ready Community

Rosie Jahner, Human Resource/Safety Support is a committee member of the Cardiac Ready Community here in Dickinson working to help educate our community of the importance of CPR and the AED. The ultimate goal is to improve the survivability of cardiac event outside of a hospital. At current, persons who experience cardiac arrest outside of a hospital have a 10% chance of surviving.

This program promotes increasing the amount of CPR and AED trained individuals within the community, as a way to improve public response in an emergency while waiting for EMS to arrive. It also identifies where the AED's are, so if one is in need, it may be easily located and publicly accessible. ABLE, Inc. is proud to have Rosie serving on the committee for this great cause!

Why Become Cardiac ready

- In rural North Dakota, there can be time delays before first responders can arrive at the scene in time to help cardiac arrest patients.
 - Overall National average time for EMS response is 7 minutes
 - National average for solely rural areas is 13 minutes
- Cardiac Ready Community designation works to improve several of the elements of cardiac care.
- Designation guidelines set by ND-DoH, AHA/ASA, ND Cardiac system of care
